Your information will used only to fulfill this student's assignment. This includes:

- A 4-page written summary of the interview, which will be shared only with the course instructor. The instructor does need to know your name and organization, to make sure that the assignment has been properly completed.
- A 3-minute oral presentation to the class.
 - You may choose whether to have your name and organization identified in this presentation. Please indicate your choice below.

Once the assignment has been graded, this consent form, the written summary, and all student and instructor notes will be destroyed, so that no participants can be identified. No results will be reported to anyone except to the instructor and to the students in the class.
